If you use commercial or private health insurance to pay for your Janssen medication



Eligible patients pay \$10 per dose

\$8,000 maximum program benefit per calendar year or 13 doses, whichever comes first, for INVEGA SUSTENNA®; \$8,000 maximum program benefit per calendar year or 4 doses, whichever comes first, for INVEGA TRINZA®; \$8,000 maximum program benefit per calendar year or 2 doses, whichever comes first, for INVEGA HAFYERA™. Terms expire at the end of each calendar year and may change. There is no income requirement. Program does not cover the cost to give patients their injections.
